Waimānalo gains access to health information

(Waimānalo, Hawai‘i). Two new computers at the Waimānalo Health Center are available for residents to access web-based health information. Installed by the Waimānalo Health Education Project, a computer is located in each of the adult and pediatric clinic reception areas, and can be accessed during health center business hours.

The purpose of Waimānalo Health Education Project—a collaborative effort among Waimānalo Health Center, Ke Ola Mamo and Papa Ola Lōkahi—is to increase knowledge within the community by providing free training and access to web-based health information.

The project receives support from Papa Ola Lōkahi via a subcontract from the National Library of Medicine through the University of California, Los Angeles.
