OHA funds coordination of health services

(Kaka'ako, Hawai'i) The Office of Hawaiian Affairs has awarded a \$100,000 planning grant to Papa Ola Lōkahi and the family of Hawaiian health organizations to develop strategies to improve the health status of Native Hawaiians.

Fulfilling its kuleana as the Native Hawaiian Board of Health, Papa Ola Lōkahi, the five Native Hawaiian Health Care Systems and the Native Hawaiian Health Scholarship Program will spend the next year assessing and gathering data, strategic planning, developing resources, and engaging in professional training and development.

Additional partnerships will be developed with community health centers and other organizations throughout Hawai'i that serve the health needs of Native Hawaiians.

This one-year planning process will provide the groundwork for OHA to annually commit its resources to support health care delivery, research, data collection and information, workforce development, health education and other strategies aimed at improving the health status of Native Hawaiians.
